Don & Helen Ambos Memorial Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Botkins High School senior with a gpa of no less than 3.0 enrolling in an accredited college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic achievement, community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Scott F. Barker Memorial Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Sidney High School graduating senior who will pursue a Bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic achievement, financial need, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Awards for 2018: Three \$1,200 scholarships.

Carol Becker Memorial Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Botkins High School senior enrolling in a trade school, college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic achievement, community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$250 scholarship.

Harry Emley and Mary Joslin Bennett Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A high school senior who resides in and attends a school within Shelby County and who wishes to study an agriculture major. (Examples: Ag Education, Ag Business, Agronomy, Animal Science, Horticulture, etc.)
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic achievement, financial need, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$450 scholarship.

Douglas & Elizabeth Borchers Baseball/Softball Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Russia High School senior. Applicants must have been a four-year member of their high school baseball or softball team. If you have not been enrolled for four years at Russia, but did play high school ball prior to and during your enrollment at Russia, you are eligible.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): demonstrated qualities of coachability, teamwork, leadership, and sportsmanship, a recommendation letter from your Varsity baseball / softball coach is **REQUIRED** to be attached, and demonstrated community and school service.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship

Douglas & Elizabeth Borchers University of Dayton Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Russia High School senior with a gpa of no less than 3.2 Preference is for a student planning to enroll at the University of Dayton. If no qualified applicants indicate they are enrolling at the University of Dayton, the scholarship may be awarded to a student enrolling in a Catholic college or university identified by the Association of Catholic Colleges and Universities.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Demonstrated community and school service, academic performance, financial need and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Edward & Merilyn Borchers Family Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Russia High School seniors pursuing adult education, a trade school or a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need; academic ability; community, religious, and school service; recommendations.
- ◆ Awards for 2018: Four \$2,000 scholarships, renewable for up to three years.

- ◆ A Botkins High School senior with a gpa of not less than 2.7 and enrolling in an accredited trade school, college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic ability, community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Botkins Student Memorial Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Botkins High School senior enrolling in an accredited trade school, college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$500 scholarship.

Botkins Trojans Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Botkins High School senior who maintains a gpa of 2.5 or higher and is pursuing an Associate's or Bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, academic ability; community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: Two \$2,500 scholarships.

Davis-Blackford Families Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Sidney High School seniors with a gpa of no less than 2.0 pursuing a Bachelor's degree. Preference will be given to an Education major, however, if no applicants are Education majors, the award may go to a qualified student pursuing another major. Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, community and school service, and recommendations
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Doc and Hilda Francis Family Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Russia High School seniors pursuing adult education, a trade school or a two-year or four-year degree.

- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, leadership and character as evidenced by community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship, renewable for up to three years.

Randy Greve Memorial Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Botkins High School senior. Preference given to a student pursuing a 2-year vocational or technical program education (secondary consideration to a 4-year degree applicant)
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$650 scholarship.

Robert E. Grubbs Foundation Scholarship Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Jackson Center High School senior attending adult education or a trade school or pursuing a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, community and school service and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: Two \$500 scholarships.

Larry Hawkins Family Scholarship Fund 1 Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Sidney High School senior or alumnus entering college for the first time. Only individuals attaining a minimum high school gpa of 3.0 and enrolling in an adult education school, trade school, or a 2-year or 4-year college or university in the coming academic year are eligible. Individuals who are enrolling in college for the first time and have not been enrolled in high school within the last three years shall be excluded from the gpa requirement.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Larry Hawkins Family Scholarship Fund 2 Application deadline: **May 21, 2018**

- ◆ A Sidney High School alumnus who is currently enrolled beyond the first year in an adult education school, trade school, or a 2-year or 4-year college or university who will be enrolled in the coming academic year. Only individuals maintaining a college cumulative gpa of 2.8 or greater are eligible.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$2,500 scholarship.

Betty Lee Riggs Hughes Nursing Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **May 21, 2018**

- ◆ A Shelby County resident pursuing a Registered Nursing degree. Eligible persons must be a year removed from high school and have surpassed college freshman status. A gpa of no less than 3.0 is required. Licensed RN's are not eligible for continuing education.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): 1) Demonstrate the empathy, compassion and the requisite patience in order to enjoy and devote oneself to a long and fruitful nursing career. 2) financial need 3) academic ability 4) recommendations, and 5) demonstrated community and school service.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

IUTIS Club Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

A high school senior who participated in the IUTIS Club boys softball program for at least four years.

- ◆ Selection based, in order of priority: Financial need, academic ability, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Must be planning to attend an accredited college or university.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$500 scholarship.

Kauffman Family Foundation Scholarship Application deadline: February 15, 2018

- ◆ High School seniors at Anna, Fairlawn, Houston, Lehman Catholic, Minster, and Sidney with a high school gpa from 3.0 to 3.7 that are enrolling in an accredited college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Academic achievement, financial need, recommendations, and community service.
- ◆ Award for 2018: Various awards totaling \$8,000

Donald E. and M. Jane Kemp Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Sidney High School seniors who reside in Shelby County and with a high school gpa from 2.5 to 3.5 and are enrolling in an accredited college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Demonstrated community and school service, financial need, academic ability, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$2,000 scholarship, renewable for up to three years.

Kiwanis Club of Sidney Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Seniors at Sidney High School, Lehman Catholic High School, Sidney Christian Academy or the Upper Valley Career Center who are residents of the Sidney City Schools district. Sidney High School Key Club members are not required to live within the Sidney City Schools District. Must have a high school gpa of no less than 2.5 and plan to pursue an Associates or Bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic ability, school and community service, financial need, recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: Various scholarship awards totaling \$9,000.

Lahrmer Family Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Botkins Local Schools seniors who will pursue a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Elaine Laughlin Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Shelby County residents who are high school seniors maintaining a high school gpa of no less than 3.6.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Awards for 2018: Two \$1,000 scholarships.

Law Student Assistance Fund Application deadline: **May 21, 2018**

- ◆ Students entering their third year of law school (current second year students approaching the third year)
- ◆ Graduate of a high school in Shelby County or an abutting county and a permanent resident of Shelby County or an abutting county. Eligible Ohio counties: Auglaize, Darke, Champaign, Logan, Mercer, Miami and Shelby.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need, above-average law school scholarship, and demonstrated leadership in undergraduate and law school activities and in community, school and church.
- ◆ Preferential consideration given to applicants who are married and have children and those who indicate a desire for the general practice of law in a rural or county-seat setting.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$3,500 scholarship.

Layton Family Foundation Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Shelby County resident who is a U.S. citizen and is a senior attending a high school in Shelby County.
- ◆ Applicants must be a first generation student (neither parent has a bachelor's degree or higher), maintains a high school gpa not less than 2.5 and will be enrolling as a full-time student at a trade school, college or university in the coming year.
- ◆ Selection based, in order of priority: Academic ability, an essay, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Dr. Edward and Anne Link Fund Application deadline: **May 21, 2018**

- ◆ Shelby County residents maintaining a college gpa of not less than 3.0 and are pursuing a major in visual arts, performing arts, or creative writing toward a Bachelor's or Master's degree. Applicants must have completed at least one year of post-secondary education. No recipient may be awarded this scholarship more than once.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Academic ability, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$2,500 scholarship.

Kyle R. Magoto Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ Russia High School graduating seniors who have a high school gpa not less than 3.0 and who will pursue an Associate's or a Bachelor's degree as a full-time student. Applicants must have participated in no less than five (5) athletic seasons throughout high school.
- ◆ Selection based upon: average academic achievement, financial need, extracurricular school activities, demonstrated church and community service, and recommendations.

- ◆ Must have a cumulative gpa of at least 2.0. Individuals who have not been enrolled in high school or a post-secondary program within the last two years need not comply with this requirement.
- ◆ Awards for 2018: Two \$1,300 scholarships.

Dorothy A. Meyer Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **May 21, 2018**

- ◆ Ft. Loramie High School graduate who has surpassed college freshman status and is pursuing an education degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: financial need, academic ability, community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship

Dave Mielke Scholarship Fund Application deadline: **February 15, 2018**

- ◆ A Botkins High School senior who has been a member of the school's Cross Country and/or Track teams.

- ◆ Public high school seniors in Shelby County, Ohio who will attend a four-year college or university (excluding Wright State University) and have a gpa of no less than 3.5.
- ◆ Must have a parent, step-parent, grandparent, full or half-sibling who is active military or a veteran of the US military, with a preference to those related to a member of the US Air Force.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Academic ability, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ Award for 2018: One \$1,000 scholarship.

Other Scholarship administered by the Community Foundation of Shelby County:

Betty Zorn Bennett Scholarship – Valedictorians and Salutatorians of Houston High School and Sidney High School. No application.

Marty Bowman Football Academic Scholarship – Sidney High School football players who meet academic standards. Not part of the CFSC application.
