Minster Students

Kauffman Family Foundation Scholarship Application deadline: **February 16, 2023**

- ◆ High School seniors at Anna, Fairlawn, Houston, Lehman Catholic, Minster, and Sidney with a high school GPA from 3.0 to 3.95 that are enrolling in an accredited college or university.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Academic achievement, financial need, recommendations, and community service.
- ◆ *Award for 2023: One \$1,100 scholarship*

Piqua Students

McColloch-Baker Insurance Agency Scholarship- Piqua Application deadline: **February 16, 2023**

- ◆ High school seniors who attend Piqua High School in Piqua, Ohio and wish to pursue an Associate's or Bachelor's degree. Students must have maintained a high school GPA of 3.0.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, academic ability, community and school service, and recommendations
- ◆ *Award for 2023: One \$1,000 scholarship*

Southeastern Schools – South Charleston, Ohio

Tom and Sandy Shoemaker Scholarship Application deadline: **February 16, 2023**

- ◆ Southeastern Local Schools (South Charleston, Ohio) seniors with a GPA between 2.5 and 3.8 on a 4.0 scale, who reside in the district and will pursue a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Demonstrated community and school service, academic ability, and recommendations.
- ◆ *Awards for 2023: Floyd & Marie Shoemaker Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000 and James Shoemaker Memorial Scholarship - \$500. Each is renewable for one (1) additional year*

Upper Valley Career Center Students

McColloch-Baker Insurance Agency Scholarship - UVCC Application deadline: **February 16, 2023**

- ◆ High school seniors who attend the Upper Valley Career Center in Piqua, Ohio and wish to pursue an Associate's or Bachelor's degree. Students must have maintained a high school GPA of 3.0.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Financial need, academic ability, community and school service, and recommendations
- ◆ *Award for 2023: One \$1,000 scholarship*

Agriculture Related

Adam E. Huelskamp Scholarship Application deadline: **February 16, 2023**

- ◆ A high school senior who resides in the school districts of Shelby, Auglaize or Mercer County, Ohio.
- ◆ A 4H or FFA member for a minimum of 4 years combined and must be participating in their final year of eligibility.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Demonstrated community and school service, financial need, employment history, and an additional essay of no less than 100 words and no more than 200 words on a designated topic.
- ◆ *Award for 2023: One \$1,000 scholarship*

Parent is an employee of Sidney Electric or Area Energy and Electric

Herbert H. & Antoinette V. Schlater Scholarship Application deadline: **February 16, 2023**

- ◆ A parent must be employed by either Sidney Electric Co. or Area Energy & Electric for a minimum of two years prior to January 1, 2023.
- ◆ Preference is given to a graduating high school senior; however, an older student may apply. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0. This requirement will not apply if the applicant has not attended high school or a post-secondary college within the last two years. Must be enrolling in adult education, a trade school or pursuing a two-year or four-year degree.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Financial need; academic ability; community, religious, and school service; recommendations.
- ◆ **Awards for 2023: One \$2,500 to a Sidney Electric Co. employee's child and one \$2,500 scholarship to an Area Energy & Electric employee's child**

Sports Specific Participation

Shelby County Youth Soccer Scholarship Application deadline: **February 16, 2023**

- ◆ High school seniors who have been involved as a player, referee, and/or coach for a minimum of four years for a team within either Shelby County Youth Soccer, Shelby County Alliance, Western Ohio United or Ohio Extreme Soccer Club South. Must have maintained a high school cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (of comparable standing if a different grade scale is in use) and are enrolling in an accredited trade school, technical school, college or university.
- ◆ One scholarship for a male applicant and one to a female applicant, however, the committee may award to applicants of the same sex, should no eligible students from one of the sexes apply.
- ◆ Selection based, in order of priority: Soccer involvement as a player, referee, and/or coach, demonstrated passion for soccer, a recommendation letter from a soccer coach or soccer mentor is **REQUIRED**, and an additional essay of no less than 100 words and no more than 200 words on a designated topic.
- ◆ **Awards for 2023: Two \$1,000 scholarships**
