**Bob Sargeant Skills Scholarship**

- ◆ Adults or graduating seniors who reside Shelby County, Ohio or in the School Districts of Shelby County, Ohio, who are enrolling in an accredited adult educational program or trade school or pursuing an Associate's Degree shall be eligible to apply.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Demonstrated interest and passion for a specific career path, demonstrated work experience, demonstrated community or school service and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2024: One \$2,000 scholarship**

**Donald E. and M. Jane Kemp Trade School Scholarship**

- ◆ Adults or graduating seniors who reside Shelby County, Ohio or in the School Districts of Shelby County, Ohio, who are enrolling in an accredited adult educational program or trade school or pursuing an Associate's Degree shall be eligible to apply.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Demonstrated interest and passion for a specific career path, demonstrated work experience, demonstrated community or school service and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2024: Four \$3,000 scholarships**

**Tom and Sandy Shoemaker Skills Scholarship**

- ◆ Adults or graduating seniors who reside in Shelby County, Ohio or in the School Districts of Shelby County, Ohio, who are enrolling in an accredited adult educational program or trade school or pursuing an Associate's Degree shall be eligible to apply.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Demonstrated interest and passion for a specific career path, demonstrated work experience, demonstrated community or school service and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2024: One \$1,000 scholarship**

**Botkins High School Seniors**

**Jim and Pat Dietz Skills Scholarship**

- ◆ Adults or graduating seniors who reside the Botkins Local School District of Botkins, Ohio shall be eligible to apply. If there are no eligible applicants residing in the Botkins Local School District, then adults or graduating high school seniors who reside in the school Districts of Shelby County, Ohio shall be eligible.
- ◆ Must be planning to attend an accredited adult education program or trade school or pursuing up to an Associate's Degree, where the completion of coursework satisfies requirements leading to a skilled profession.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Demonstrated interest and passion for a specific career path, demonstrated work experience, demonstrated community or school service and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2024: Two \$1,000 scholarships**

**Fort Loramie High School Seniors**

**Thomas E. Schafer Skills Scholarship**

- ◆ Fort Loramie High School seniors.
- ◆ Must be planning to attend an accredited adult education program or trade school or pursuing up to an Associate's Degree, where the completion of coursework satisfies requirements leading to a skilled profession.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Demonstrated interest and passion for a specific career path, demonstrated work experience, demonstrated community and school service, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2024: One \$2,000 scholarship**

## **Christian Academy, Lehman Catholic and Sidney High Schools**

### **Bruce and Lynn Lindsey Skills Scholarship**

- ◆ Adults or graduating seniors from Lehman Catholic High School, Sidney Christian Academy, and Sidney High School who are enrolling in an accredited adult educational program or trade school or pursuing an Associate's Degree shall be eligible to apply.
- ◆ Selection based upon (in order of priority): Demonstrated interest and passion for a specific career path, demonstrated work experience, demonstrated community or school service, and recommendations. Preference given to applicants seeking a career in HVAC, plumbing or electrical.
- ◆ **Award for 2024: Two \$2,000 scholarships**

#### **Woody Sturm and Sturm Family Skills Scholarship**

- ◆ Sidney High School seniors who participated on the SHS Football team for no less than their junior and senior years of high school.
- ◆ Must be planning to attend an accredited adult education program or trade school or pursuing up to an Associate's Degree at an accredited college.
- ◆ Selection based upon: Number of years on the SHS Football team, character, work ethic, and recommendations.
- ◆ **Award for 2024: One \$1,000 scholarship**
